- (1) "apiculture by-products" means honey, beeswax, royal jelly, propolis or pollen not intended for human consumption.
- (2) Hides and skins, ruminant intestines, bones and bone products containing vertebral column and skull - see restrictions
- (3) Note:- Photographic gelatine from Japan and USA is permitted - see 2004/407 and 2006/311 for details of cert etc.

(4)

- (a) animal by-products from aquatic animals and derived products from aquatic animals;
- (b) aquatic invertebrates and derived products from aquatic invertebrates;
- (c) terrestrial invertebrates, including any of their transformation forms, such as larvae, and derived products therefrom;
- (d) products generated by the animals referred to in points (a), (b) and (c), such as fish eggs;
- (e) Category 3 material comprising of animals and parts thereof of the zoological orders of Rodentia and Lagomorpha.

**Note:-** fishing bait for purposes other than feeding to pet fish is detailed elsewhere

(5) **Category 3 material Annex**

- (a) carcasses and parts of animals slaughtered or, in the case of game, bodies or parts of animals killed, and which are fit for human consumption in accordance with Community legislation, but are not intended for human consumption for commercial reasons;
- (b) carcasses and the following parts originating either from animals that have been slaughtered in a slaughterhouse and were considered fit for slaughter for human consumption following an ante-mortem inspection or bodies and the following parts of animals from game killed for human consumption in accordance with Community legislation:
  - (i) carcasses or bodies and parts of animals which are rejected as unfit for human consumption in accordance with Community legislation, but which did not show any signs of disease communicable to humans or animals;
  - (ii) heads of poultry;

(6) 'processed animal protein, including mixtures and products other than petfood containing such protein, and compound feeds containing such proteins as defined in Article 3(2)(h) of Regulation (EC) No 767/2009'.

(7) covers raw material in article 6 points a to j only
